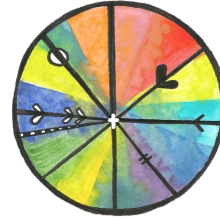

*What is coaching?*

Coaching is a forward-looking relationship (differentiating it from counseling) in which I guide you to identify and leverage more fully your gifts, wisdom, and experiences. Individual coaching calls are structured to help you create tangible action steps (differentiating coaching from spiritual direction) in service of your larger goals. I root coaching in an invitation to reflect, in encouragement, and in gentle challenge.

*What is the time and money investment involved in coaching?*

Most coachees start with packages of 6 or 10 one-hour calls, spaced at intervals designed to give coachees time to implement action steps and momentum toward their goals. Current rates are available at [laurastephensreed.com](http://laurastephensreed.com).
